Eligibility	Candidate should have completed third year of optometry training (without any backlog/s) from a recognized optometry school/college/institute
Selection process	On merit basis, through an online written test (50 MCQs, Syllabus: B-Optometry)
Online examination	All eligible candidates will be informed about the online admission examination details to the registered email in advance. Also, a mock examination will be conducted to familiarize applicants with the online examination platform.
Last date of application	20 May 2023
Date of online examination	4 June 2023
Application fee	INR 1180/- (including of GST)
Internship course fee	INR 1,20,360/- (Tuition fee: INR 1,02,000/- + GST INR 18,360/-)
Food charges	If a trainee chooses to stay in the hostel, INR 25,200/-amount for six months to be paid at the time of admission (charges are campus specific)
Accommodation	Shared accommodation provided on the campus at no cost to the trainee
